

## **Early career board member**

- co-opted as board members for a one-year term. A call for candidates will be launched every year at the BSTH annual meeting. The executive board of the BSTH will select the candidate for the next year. An early career board member can apply for a following mandate, with a maximum of two consecutive mandates.
